Assembly Instructions

Before You Start: Loosely tighten all screws first. Once all screws are positioned, fully tighten them to secure the assembly.

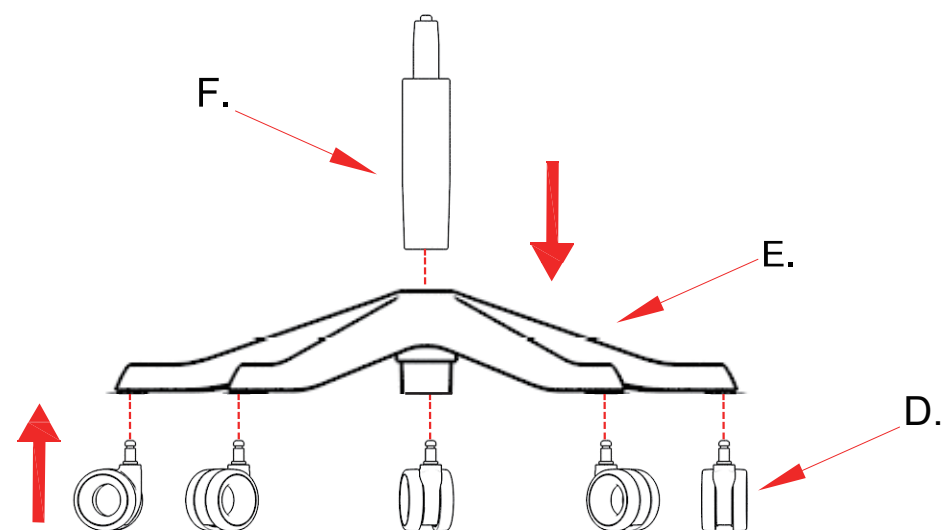


1 Install the Wheels and the Gas Lift

Insert the wheels (D) into the base (E).

Place the gas lift (F) into the center of the base.

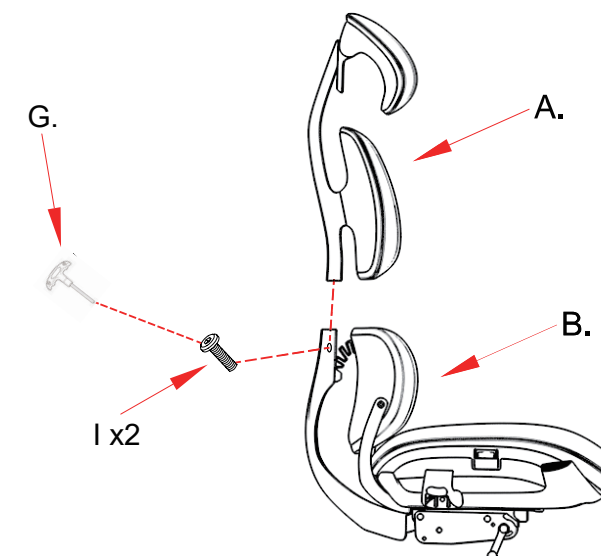
Note: Ensure each wheel is securely pushed into the leg base.



2 Install the Backrest

Use 2 screws (Type I) and the Allen wrench (G) to attach the backrest (A) to the seat (B).

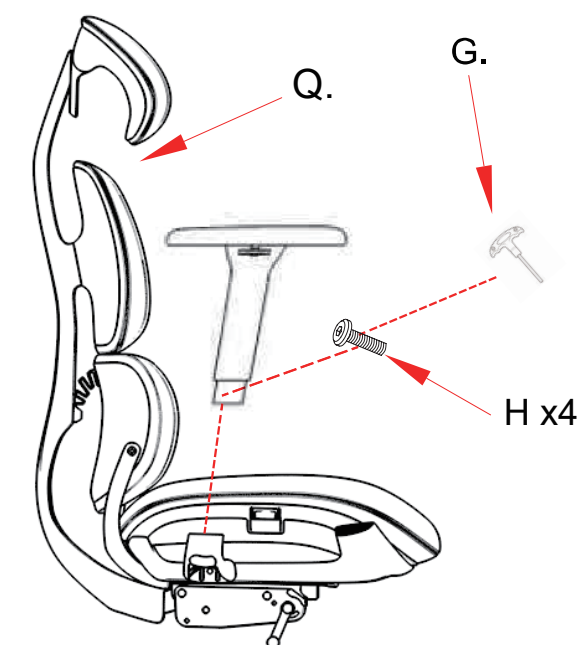
Tip: Align the screw holes carefully before tightening the screws.



3 Attach the Armrests

Use 4 screws (Type H) per armrest and the Allen wrench (G) to attach the left and right armrests (C).

Note: Check the labeling (L/R) to ensure the armrests are installed on the correct sides.

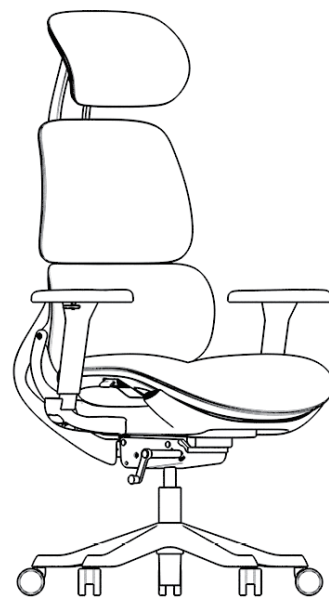
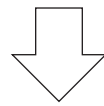
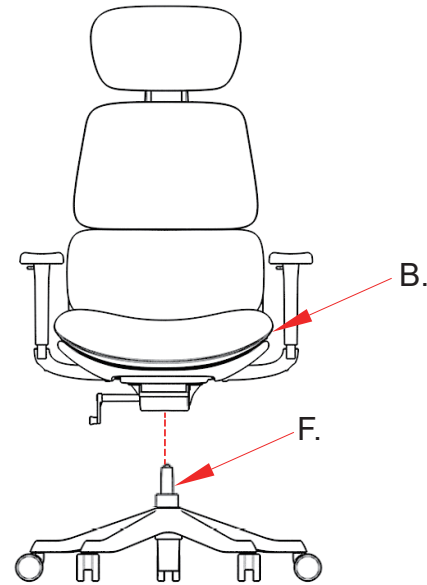

Insert the Gas Lift into the Seat

Insert the gas lift (F) into the seat (B).

Tip: Apply firm pressure to ensure the gas lift is fully inserted

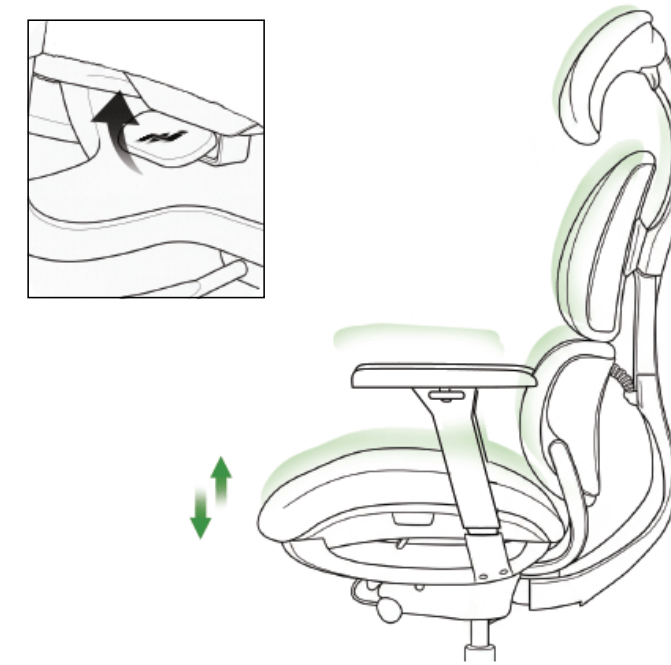


Adjustment Instructions

Seat Height Adjustment

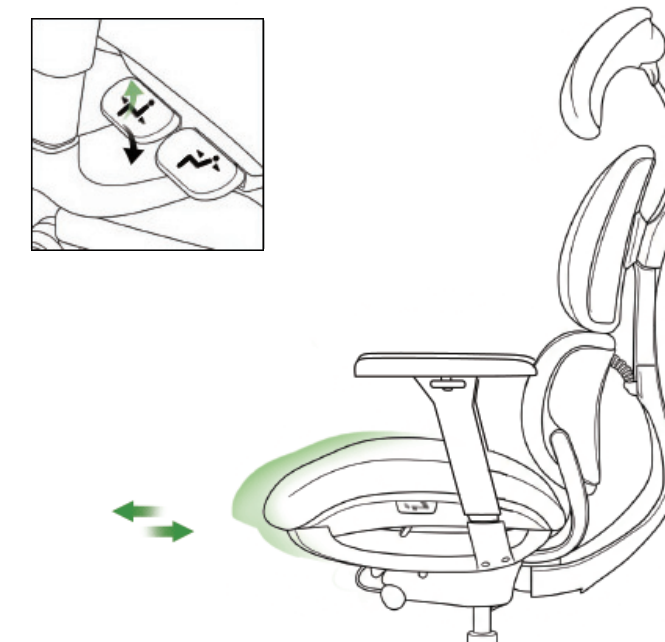
Lift the lever on the right side of the seat to adjust the seat height via the gas lift.

Seat Depth Adjustment

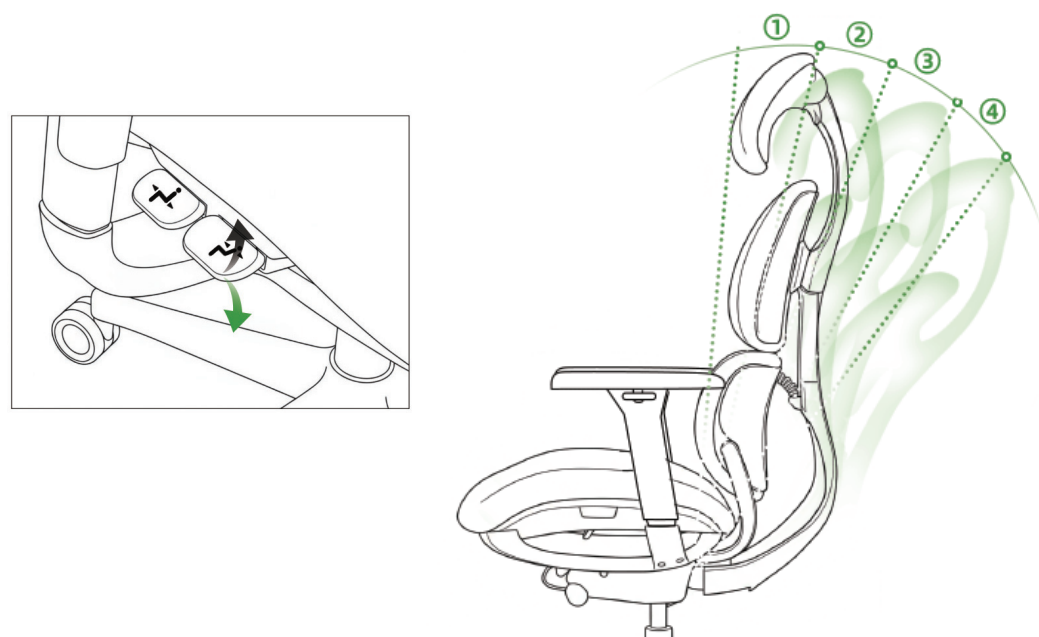
Lift the paddle to slide the seat forward or backward, then release to lock in place.



3 Backrest Recline Adjustment

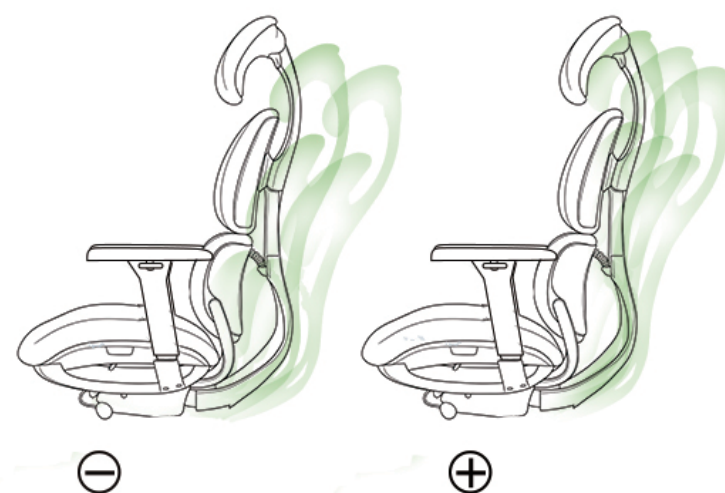
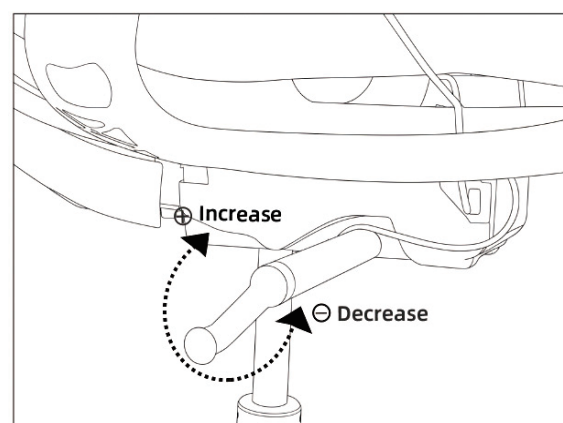
UNLOCK: Push the Paddle down to unlock the backrest, allowing it to move freely with your body.

LOCK: Push it up to lock the backrest at a fixed position.



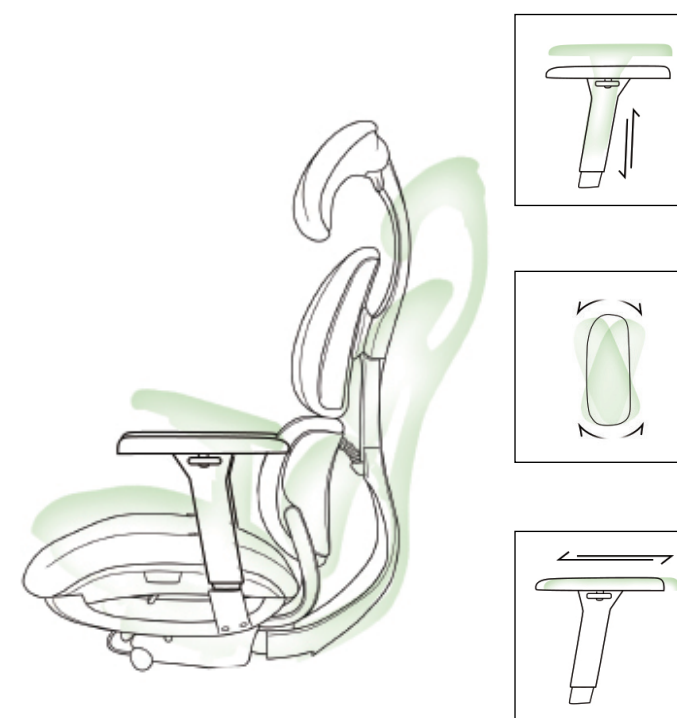
4 Recline Resistance Adjustment

Use the rotary lever to adjust the backrest tension.



5 Armrest Adjustment

When reclining, the armrests tilt synchronously with the backrest.

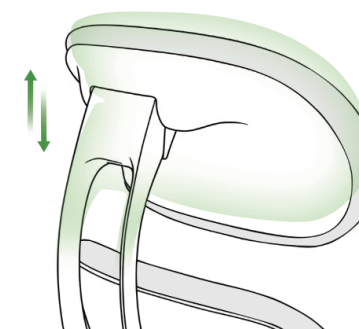


Height: Press the button under the armrest to raise or lower it. Release to lock in place.

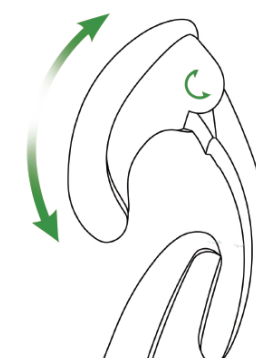
Rotation: Rotate the armrest pad left or right to a desired angle.

Depth: Slide the armrest pad forward or backward to adjust.

6 Headrest Adjustment



Height: Push the headrest upward to raise it or downward to lower it.



Fine Angle: Adapts angle automatically as your head lean back.

Safety Instructions

1. Do not use on slippery surfaces. Ensure the product is used on a stable, non-slip surface.
2. Avoid placing drinks on the product. Spills can cause discoloration or damage to the surface material. Wipe up any moisture immediately to prevent staining.
3. Do not sit on the product with more than one person at a time. This can lead to instability and potential injury.

3. For defective products, FlexiSpot will provide a replacement shipped at no cost within the continental United States via FedEx Ground. Expedited shipping is available at the customer's expense. International shipping costs are the customer's responsibility.

What is Not Covered

1. Issues not resulting from material or workmanship defects.
2. Damage from normal wear and tear, improper installation, maintenance, misuse, abuse, negligence, accidents, or alterations.
3. Accessories, connected materials, and products not manufactured by FlexiSpot.
4. Damage from failure to follow instructions and guidelines for the product's intended use.
5. The warranty is void if the product is returned with removed, damaged, or tampered labels, or if there are any alterations.
